Basis for Grant Amount Paid to Students

This law requires that Milan Institute award these funds to exceptionally needy students. Milan Institute has reviewed the 2020-21 and/or 2021-22 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and/or alternative determination documentation provided by students to identity students eligible for the CRRSAA/ARP Grant. As additional qualifications, each recipient must be a current student (actively attending and not currently on a leave of absence or another inactive status) and must have been attending the College starting on or after February 1, 2021. Students starting before February 1, 2021 may be eligible based on an alternative determination. Students are required to complete all necessary forms and return them to their Campus' Education Finance Advisor, so Milan may properly disburse the award.

Pell eligible students will receive a base monthly payment of \$350.00 that will be paid on the monthly as long a student remains active. Monthly payments will continue for up to four (4) months and will cease when funds are exhausted.

CRRSAA/ARP grant funds can be used to pay for any component of in your Cost of Attendance. This includes housing, food, transportation, health care, childcare, or other emergency expenses you deem necessary.
