



## **Vaccination Policies**

The following are the student vaccination policy, organized by program and state. If a program or location is not listed below, there is no student vaccination policy in place.

### **Medical Assisting**

- California, Texas, Idaho:  
Student vaccinations are not provided by Milan Institute. Vaccinations may be required by an extern site or employer and are the student's responsibility. If you are pregnant or become pregnant, you may be unable to receive the Hepatitis B Vaccinations Series. You should consult your physician for guidance.
- Nevada
  - Sparks:  
Student vaccinations are not provided by Milan Institute. Vaccinations may be required by an extern site or employer and are the student's responsibility. If you are pregnant or become pregnant, you may be unable to receive the Hepatitis B Vaccinations Series. You should consult your physician for guidance.
  - Las Vegas:  
Hepatitis B and MMR vaccinations and TB tests are provided if required by the extern site. If you are pregnant or become pregnant, you may be unable to receive the Hepatitis B Vaccinations Series. You should consult your physician for guidance.

### **Dental Assistant/Registered Dental Assistant**

- California  
The Hepatitis B Vaccination Series is required for externship and employment as a Dental Assistant. The fee for obtaining the Hepatitis B series will be paid by Milan Institute.  
Notice to pregnant students: If you are pregnant or become pregnant, you may be unable to receive the Hepatitis B Series. You should consult your physician for guidance.  
When required by an extern site or employer, Milan Institute will pay for a TB test.
- Nevada  
Hepatitis B vaccination is required and provided for all students enrolled in the Dental Assisting program. TB tests are also provided for students. If you are pregnant or become pregnant, you may be unable to receive the Hepatitis B Vaccinations Series. You should consult your physician for guidance. Any other vaccination required by an extern site is the student's responsibility.

## Pharmacy Technician

- Nevada

Vaccinations may be required by the extern site. If you are pregnant or become pregnant, you may be unable to receive the vaccinations series. You should consult your physician for guidance. Inability to receive required vaccinations may affect externship opportunities.
