

How Much Does College Cost?

The cost of attendance (sometimes called COA) refers to the average amount a full-time student can expect to spend while enrolled at Milan Institute. Students may not foresee all the expenses involved in attending college, and the exact cost depends on factors such as housing status and residency.

Though students must determine a budget that meets their needs, the following is the annual estimated COA. These numbers include the Indirect Costs estimated during the student's enrollment.
