Placement Rate Determinations

Council on Occupational Education:

Placement cohorts are determined by campus and program and use an annual reporting period. Placement rates are calculated on students who graduate from the program during the reporting period as well as students who left the program before graduation but have acquired sufficient competencies for employment in the field (or related field) as evidenced by such employment during the reporting period. Graduates are counted as placed if they are employed in the field (or related field) of instruction, have entered the military, or are continuing their education. COE does allow for graduates who are unavailable for employment (due to conduct, pregnancy, other serious health-related issues, caring for ill family members, death, etc.) and graduates who have refused employment (by failing to keep interview appointments, enrolling in the program of instruction strictly for personal use, or simply refused an employment offer in the field of instruction) to be excluded from the placement calculations. The calculation for placement is defined as: total number of placements (including graduates who went into the military or continued their education) divided by total number of completers minus unavailable graduates and those who have refused employment.

National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts and Sciences:

Placement cohorts combine the main and all branch campuses and use the most recent contract end date. Placement rates are calculated on graduates from the graduation cohort who are eligible for placement, based on the most recent contract end date. A student may count as placed if they are employed in a field for which their training prepared them. If a student has graduated from the program, the school needs to determine whether he/she is eligible for placement. All graduates must be declared eligible for placement unless they meet one of the following five conditions for ineligibility: the graduate is deceased, the graduate is permanently disabled, the graduate is deployed for military service/duty, the graduate studied under a student visa and is ineligible for employment in the U.S., or the graduate continued his/her education at an institution under the same ownership. The calculation for placement is defined as: total number of placements divided by total number of completers minus ineligible completers.

Nevada – the Commission on Postsecondary Education calculates placement rates by determining the number of students who graduated from 1/1 – 12/31 and number of students who gained employment from 1/1 – 12/31.
